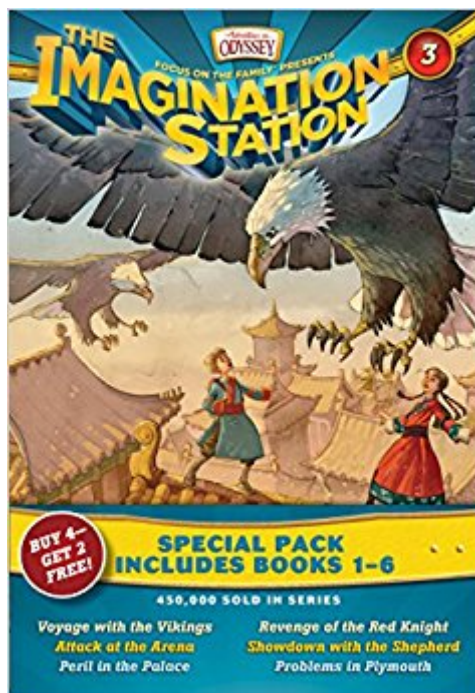

I purchased this set for my 9 year old daughter for Christmas. She loves the Magic Tree House series and I thought this would be a similar series with a Christian worldview. The books were very easy, fun reads for her. Although she thoroughly enjoyed them all, I think this set is more geared toward the grade 2-3 reading level, or the struggling grade 4 reading level. My 9 year old son loved these so much he took them to school! And now the kids in school are waiting in line to read them. Needless to say I will be ordering some more.

I have two 8 year old grandsons who are thrilled with these books! Their parents say the boys want to keep reading when it's time to go to bed. I told them I will buy more of these for them!

My boys have loved reading The Magic Treehouse books. I was looking for something similar, but new for my 7 year old, since he enjoys reading them and had reached the end of that series. These are made by the Adventures in Odyssey folks. That made me smile because I vividly remember listening to Adventures in Odyssey in the car as a kid. The reading level on these is right along with the Magic Treehouse reading level. They look almost exactly like those books on the inside. Plenty of pictures intermingled in with the text. Large print. Chapters are rather short. The books themselves are a little longer than a Magic Treehouse book. (72 pages vs. 115 pages based on the two books I just grabbed off the shelf at random to compare.) There is also a Secret Word Puzzle at the end of the book. My boys really like these and I highly recommend them.

Our family loves these stories! They are great readers for kids. Great morals, inspirational and fun. My kids are dyslexic, these books are great in-between books. It's their level of thought process and story but with bigger, easier font to read. I am so thankful for these! Even my boys like to read them!

My seven year old daughter needed a new series to read that would challenge her. This series is so wonderful and refreshing because it has a Christian world view.

We bought these books for my three boys (7, 5, & 3). We have made it through the first three books and my children are in love. It's filled with adventure and truth. They cannot wait to read the next book. My boys are full of adventure and can't sit long for anything. We usually sit for 45 - 60 minutes and read. After we finish the books we look at the history and find out more about the characters. Best books I've read with my kids!

My 8-year old son LOVES these books. He's a new reader and was skeptical at first, but now he is asking for the rest of the set.
