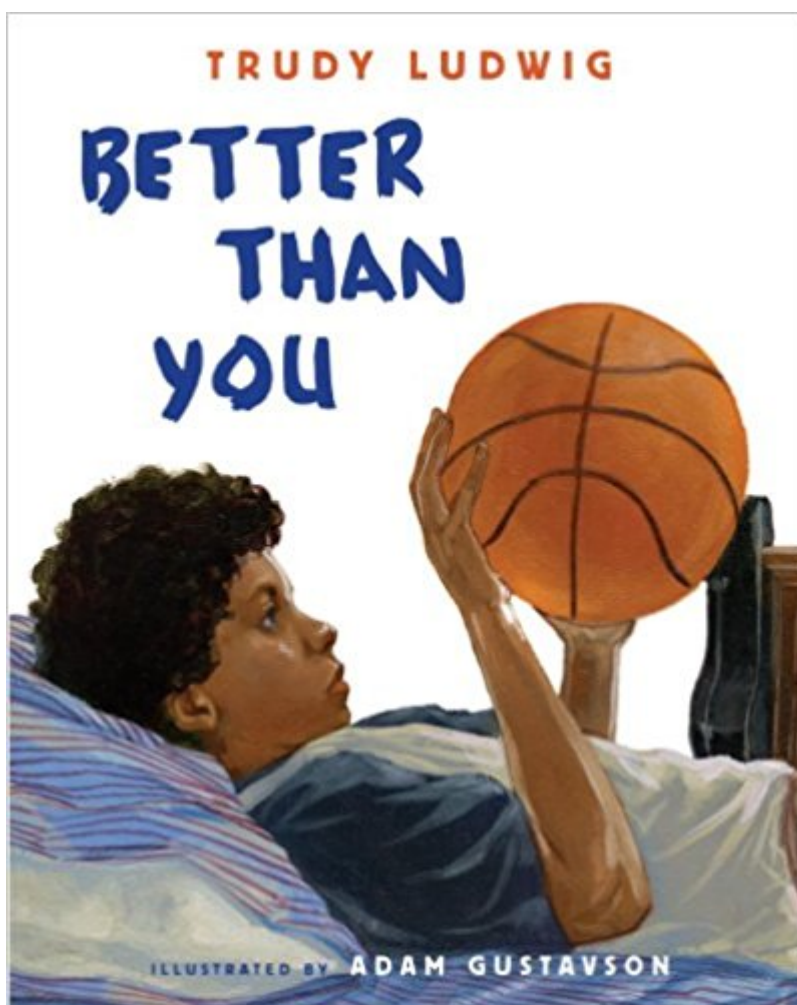

Trudy Ludwig fills a need for young readers who benefit from stories that guide them through the difficulties of unpleasant social interactions. This is a wonderful addition to any library and a good tool for guidance counselors and teachers who want to help students navigate tough situations.

The point got across, and this book is good for a discussion starter. I wish, however, that it would have included more depth. Because the main character did not experience much (not enough drama), the connection with the story could be lost for a child reading this himself without an adult leading him in discussion about it. I am an elementary school counselor and I am successful using this book in small groups and mediation sessions.
