

Most of the time I am not interested in biographical stories; however, this one (*The Long Loneliness: The Autobiography of the Legendary Catholic Social Activist* by Dorothy Day), proved to be an interesting and compelling read. Dorothy Day was the founder of the Catholic Worker Movement and spent a lifetime (She died in 1980) fighting for social justice. It begins with her life as a journalist and was an atheist before she converted to Catholicism. She was committed to her cause of peace, racial justice and the causes of the poor. Personally, I am not into altruism and do not agree with Dorothy Day's far left socialist leaning philosophy; nevertheless, I admire her dedication to helping the poor and social activism. This kind of book is usually not "my cup of tea" but I did find this autobiography a sometimes interesting read. For anyone interested in Catholicism, socials justice causes and the life of a legendary figure, Dorothy Day, who was one of the early leaders in this field should read this book. Rating: 5 Stars.
