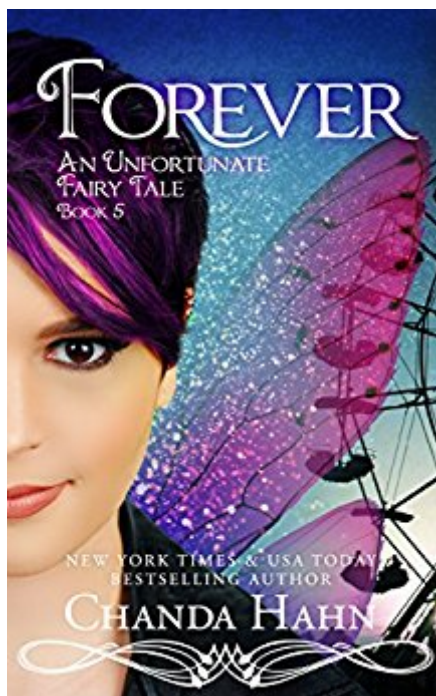


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Forever (An Unfortunate Fairy Tale Book 5)

I feel so lost now that the series is over! I must say, I had absolutely no idea how Ms. Hahn was going to make everything tie together, but she did a fabulous job of it. In this book, Mina must make the most difficult decision one could ever make- Hope Teague changes or kill him. Anybody who has read the other four novels knows what an evil man Teague is, but Mina loves him (and so do I!). Just like in previous novels, Teague puts Mina through a lot of horrible situations. She's forced to make difficult decisions and take on responsibilities that should never belong to a teenager. Her decisions are no longer about the Story, but about the two planes that she and Teague travel. Although I absolutely loved this book, I only gave it 4/5 stars. My primary reason- there is a section of the book that is strictly Mina and Teague. I really enjoyed this part but feel like it could have been more detailed/used more interactions between the two. The story line revolves around

this relationship so it should have been built up some more prior to the books climax. Other reasons- I found at least two discrepancies, some parts weren't as emotional as I felt they should have been, and there were a couple parts where I wish Mina had been more assertive. There were scenes where she was like Super Mina and took charge of the situation like the strong girl we all know she is. Then there were just a few parts where I wondered, "Why didn't she do/say.....?" Overall, though, I laughed, I cried (a few times), and I am happy with the ending. I highly recommend this to EVERYONE!

From the moment I read the first page of the first book, I was set. What I liked about this book in the series was that from the beginning it prepared you for the end of the series. Everything felt very climaxy (totally not a word). The stakes were high, the battles were boss and the emotions were heightened. The only thing I didn't like about this book (it pains me to even type those words) was that a part at the end with Teague was kind of skimmed over. The reaper thing was not as highlighted as I think it should have been so I had to re-read that page to make sure what was going on. I think the whole "challenge the death reaper and take his place" should have been explained more and more emotion put in. However, somehow, Chanda Hahn found a way to end this series with a slam dunk of endings. I was worried for a second. By I'm very satisfied with the ending and I think it did Mina and all the other loved (and unloved) characters justice so kudos! By the way I did cry three times during this book. I cried more than I did when I watched "A Walk to Remember" !!!!!!!

First let me say that I truly enjoyed the first 4 books of this series. Don't get me wrong, the writing isn't going to win any prizes, but the story and characters are so engaging that I devoured the books. Then I got to book 5. The entire second half of this book was a scattered disappointment. I invested enough in the main characters to feel like they deserved an ending that respected their personal growth and this ending did not. I gave the book three stars because I liked it until about the middle when it fell apart for me and that first half deserves some recognition.

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
