

Blood, sweat, and sex Every books and novella in this set are great reads. Terrific prose, so whether gay, straight, bi, or neuter these books will make you hot. Forget the sex, the emotions portrayed with a delicacy that weeps off the page. The conflicts develop to grab the reader. Each book worth the price of the set. These are not slam, bam, thank you man, but a build-up to relationships. Dan Sexton is a gifted author. Without going through the entire set, I will focus on two. The bonus book, Pet Monster, is a modern update to Alberto Moravia's *Io and Lui* and *Me and him* or *The Two of Us*. In Moravia's version, the penis takes over the man's life, even talks to him. In Pet Monster the appendage does not converse but changes Ritchie's behavior with intrusiveness at inopportune moments, making his

adolescence hell. The story rings true from the Catholic priest's advice, to a roommate's self-pleasuring in a dorm room while Richie feigns sleep. His "awakening" connotes the physical and the emotional that shows revelations don't need fireworks. *Wrestling with Love*, book 3, has a different tone. Love dominates the theme organically. Often love and friendship fling themselves onto opposites, people that start off antagonistic, nothing like love-at-first-sight. In *Wrestling*, two protagonists have more in common than wrestling. It is hard not to root for the men, hoping they find the love they crave and deserve. But the story deviates, expands, makes everything large and complicated, the way life does. Nothing is as seems. Excellent plot. This set portrays multi-dimensional characters. Subplots peek from under the sheets: love, hate, peer pressure, body dysmorphia, insecurity, and fear intertwine with sex—the substance of good books. That these are well-written makes them more than LGBTQ, but belong to everyone who craves understanding of life, love, and missed opportunity. Thrill too. Enjoy. I did.

Dan Sexton has the writing gifts to write about any subject, but the fact that he writes Men for Men stories and pulls them off with such unique power is a true kudo to his talent. Yes, he is able to write some of the most sensual sexual scenes better than most any author today, but the fact that he places his same sex encounters in an atmosphere of a wide assortment of young men coming to grips with their sexual identity and making that aspect of his story equally important to his steamy scenes is really quite remarkable. Or as he states in his very brief bio. "I'm passionate about penning steamy and intelligent stories.
