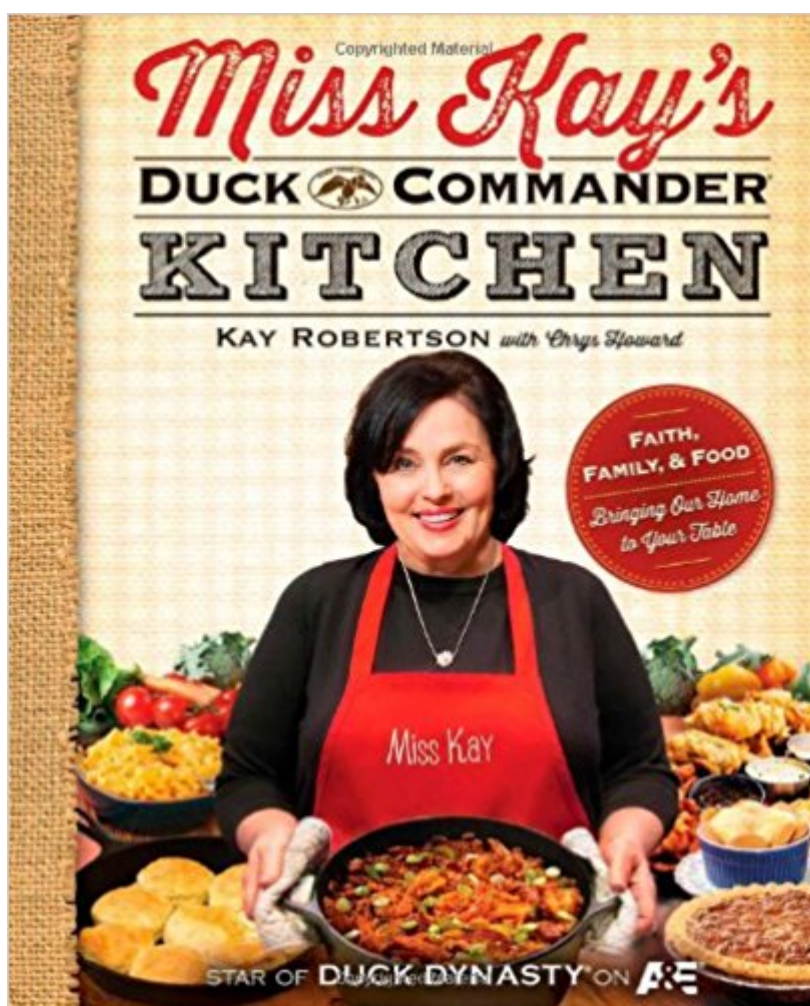


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Miss Kay's Duck Commander Kitchen: Faith, Family, And Food--Bringing Our Home To Your Table

Miss Kay's family recipes are a delicious mix of traditional Southern dishes, with a lively dash of Louisiana Cajun thrown in, and generous servings of faith and love. The delightful matriarch of the Duck Commander dynasty is a gifted and artful cook. This beautifully designed book includes many fun photographs and is easy to use. The whole Robertson clan contributes recipes; it's a great read for both men and women. Miss Kay shares stories and sage advice, with techniques for creating the most delicious meals with easily prepared, classic Southern soul-food, like creamy macaroni & cheese (cheese melted on top, yum), buttermilk biscuits, and Lisa's pecan chicken. There are savory Cajun dishes like Willie's chicken strips, spicy brisket, and easy crawfish étouffée. Satisfying deserts are down-home good, including classic cookies, Phil's pralines, Miss Kay's famous banana pudding, and Jase's favorite sweet potato pie. This pie motivates him to put up Miss Kay's vast collection of Christmas decorations! Now, we can enjoy Miss Kay's cooking too; real food for real people. gather around the dinner table and create good memories. It's a book to treasure, and a great gift during the holiday season. A lot of thought went into this classy, friendly, easy to use, lovingly photographed, and downright hospitable cookbook. It's like a big, warm hug from Miss Kay. You'll feel welcomed into the circle of Miss Kay's family and friends, with fun stories and plentiful, practical, and delicious recipes. Each chapter begins with a story from Miss Kay, all the recipes include helpful notes. The beautiful layout and photos are a treat. The recipes consist of wholesome ingredients that are easily obtainable from any grocery store. Only a few recipes (towards the back of the book) call for wild game, and Miss Kay suggests easy substitutes if we lack access to this. For example, Miss Kay helpfully suggests substituting precooked rotisserie chicken for squirrel in "Boiled Squirrel & Dumplings," page 199. The resulting chicken & dumplings are savory and irresistible! The cookbook walks us through traditional dishes and deserts, easily incorporated into any home. Some of the Louisiana recipes call for a dash of Cajun seasoning, which can be any brand found locally. Or, you can look for Miss Kay's preferred kind here: *Â Duck Commander Phil Robertson's Cajun Style Original Seasoning* *Â* or *Â Duck Commander Phil Robertson's Cajun Style Zesty Seasoning*. The index at the back of the book is also useful. Chapters include: *Cooking for Phil*, *Feeding My Boys*, *The Women My Boys Love*, *Learn to Cook*, *When the Grandkids Come Over*, *Company's Coming*, *Louisiana at Its Best*, *Dinner on the Grounds*, *Miss Kay's "Muffins and Mentoring" Group*, *Our Cajun Christmas*, *Wild Game Cooking*, *Remembering Granny*, *Miss Kay's most important ingredients are her love, faith, and kindness, with gratitude for the gifts God provides. Measure for measure, the only thing greater than her delicious cooking is her charm, and that's saying something!* The extended Robertson family and community of West Monroe, Louisiana, is blessed with Miss Kay, her beautiful spirit, and her delicious homemade cooking. I will preface my review with this statement: I have never seen the television show from which I presume this cookbook is based on. I learned more about Miss Kay, and her family, by reading her cookbook which features family stories, photos and recipes. I thoroughly enjoyed reading about her family and their walk in faith. I loved reading the enclosed Bible scripture included within her cookbook's pages. As to the recipes: They are down home country-style recipes. The kind of food you love to eat as it makes you feel good. In other words, comfort food. Some of the recipes you will find in her cookbook include: Phil's Famous Pralines, Swiss Steak & Sauteed Mushrooms, Jase's Creamed Potatoes, Willie's Favorite Fried Chicken, Willie's Famous Chicken Strips, Hot Waffles, Pawpaw Phil's Homemade Ice Cream, Jay's Duck Wraps, Hushpuppies, Pineapple Cheese Salad, Mayhaw Jelly, Blackberry Jam Cake. Be aware some of the recipes are kind of spicy sounding as they call for Cajun seasoning and this includes the Willie's Famous Chicken Strips found in the When the Grandkids Come Over chapter. I loved reading Miss Kay's folksy feel good cookbook. Her stories are precious, and I will probably keep this cookbook as it's fun to read; although I probably have most of the recipes (or very similar recipes in my recipes files) found in her cookbook. I love Miss Kay's cookbooks, this one and her party one. Everything I have ever made from them turns out perfect, is easy to make, with easy to follow instructions, and easy to find ingredients. Her dishes aren't expensive to make and every one of them are delicious, family favorites!!! I love comfort food and southern cooking. Miss Kay's recipe's are simple, easy to assemble and taste great. This book is for beginner cooks, the list of ingredients, except for crawfish, are easily purchased at your grocer. Most can be assembled and cooked in an hour or less. The only problem I have seen is that some, not all, baking dishes are missing oven temps, but most cooks know that casseroles are usually baked at 350. I would imagine that the next publishing will include those errors. I can't recommend Miss Kay's cookbook enough.

The wild game recipes took me back to my dad's contributions to many a table and conjured many fond memories of adventures in nature with him. The tips are all down to earth and spot on.
