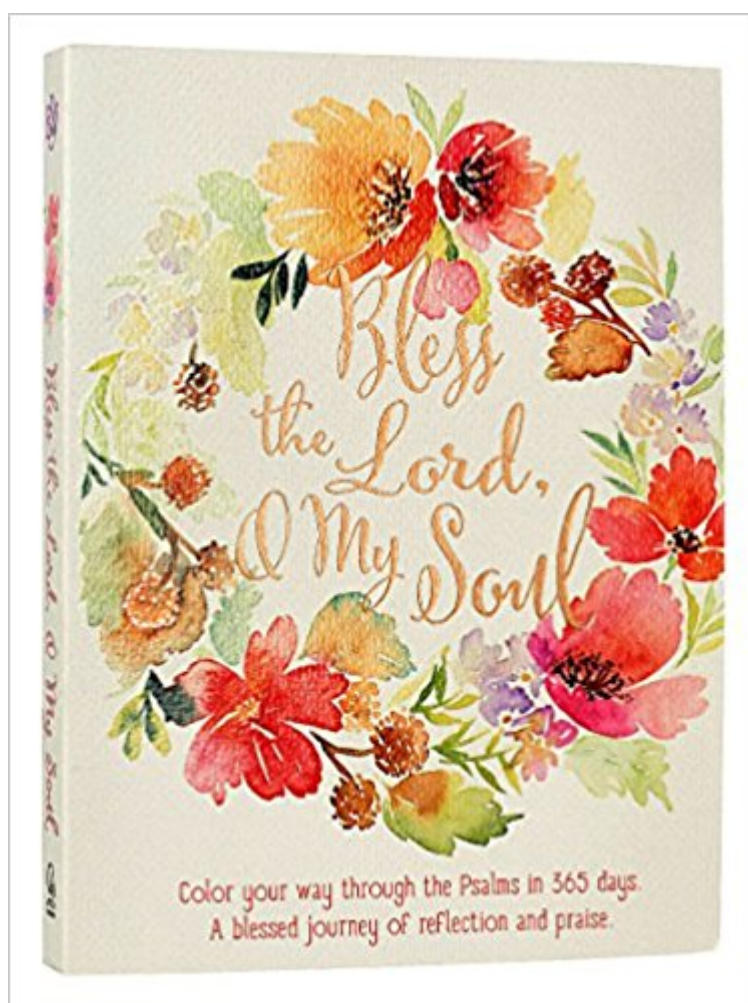

The book is bound in heavy-duty stock with a rose gold foil title and applications of spot-varnish. The design is completed by the rose gold gilt-edged pages. This is a really lovely book which focuses on the Psalms. It is a 365 day walk through the book with 52 coloring pages (one per week.) The daily pages include a reading from the Psalms along with a reflection and lines which allow you to journal your thoughts (and perhaps prayers) on each page. By the end of the year, you will have read through the entire book of Psalms. I always turn to the Psalms when I am troubled by life. I know that the Psalmist went through many struggles and in his words, I see my own troubles and questions. While I am starting the book mid-year and I think that works perfectly, I also think that this book makes a wonderful

holiday gift so that an individual can start the New Year beginning with January first and begin with the Psalms 1. The illustrations are all licensed through Shutterstock and are detailed. Many of the designs include intricate and small areas to color. The translation used in this book is The Holy Bible, English Standard Version. The book has a beautifully illustrated cover and gold metallic gilding on the edge of each page. It is 7 1/2 x 5 5/8 x 7/8 inches. I am working on each design each day with the intent of finishing one per week. I do the daily reading and then color a bit as I ponder it. I then write down my thoughts and put the book away for the next day. It makes for a lovely way to spend a few minutes a day in contemplation of the Scripture. I am using my colored pencils on this book due to the way wet medium bleeds through the page (see below.) This is what I found while coloring in this book and testing the paper with my coloring medium. 52 Coloring pages with 365 days of verses from the Psalms. Printed on both sides of the page though designs are only on one side with verses on the reverse. Paper is thin, white, slightly rough and non-perforated. Sewn Binding. The book is thick but I can open it fairly flat due to the sewn binding. Designs merge into the binding area. Alcohol and water-based markers bleed through the page. India ink pens bleed through in a spotty fashion. Gel pens leave colorful shadows on the back of the page but do not bleed through. Colored pencils work well with this paper. It is slightly rough and has good "tooth" to grab pigment. I had good results with both oil and wax based pencils. I could layer and blend well with both. Hard lead pencils left dents through to the back of the page. I use and you should consider using a blotter page of cut down card stock or a couple of sheets of heavyweight paper below your coloring page. This will keep ink and marring dents from damaging the rest of the book.

I'm not particularly interested in coloring these pages, but I chose this because it has scripture broken into bite-size daily chunks with space for note-taking. The paperback binding holds up well to daily use without pages ripping or falling out. The weekly coloring pages are beautiful on their own, even if you don't color them. I will look for more in this series.

I love the book itself, but the condition it came to me in did not appear new. The cover was torn and showed considerable wear. The pages inside were sticky and stuck together. If I bought it as a used book, it wouldn't be as big of a deal. However, to have purchased it as a new book and received this in this condition, I am disappointed.
