

The author give much more information on the Panama City area, and only a very small amount relating to Chiriqui Province, so depending on where one is interested in, will determine how useful the book may, or may not be to the reader. It does have several typos which could have been easily prevented with some proofreading, but other than annoying, it does not detract from the useful information within the book.
