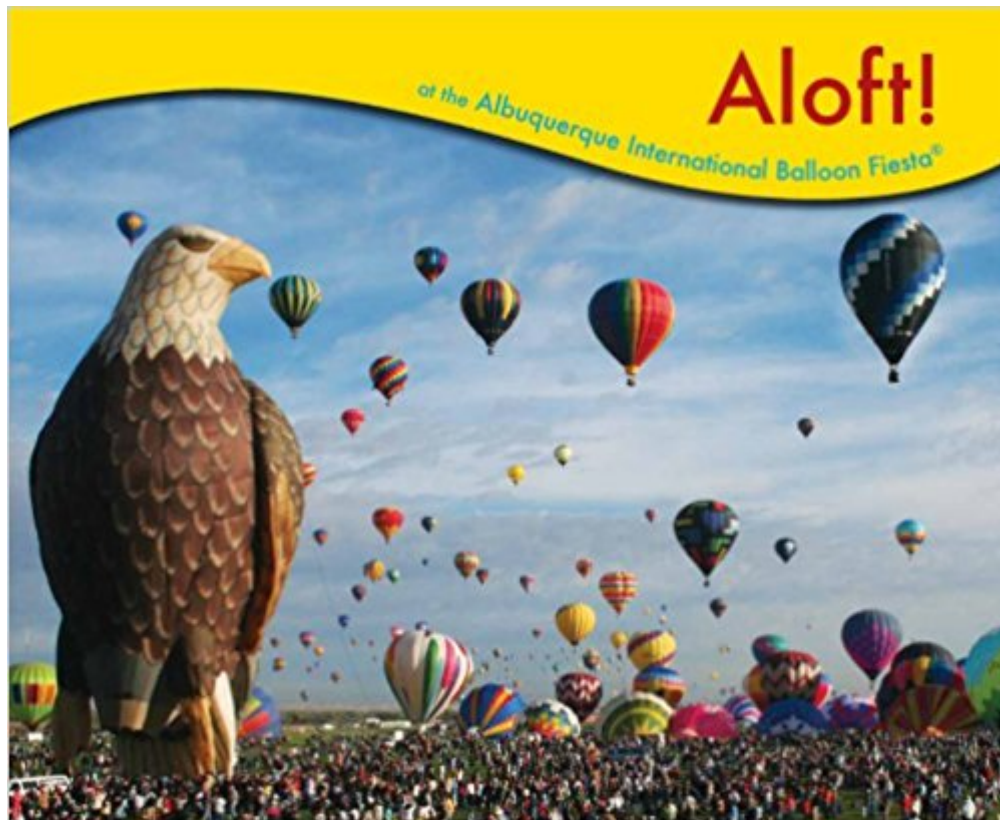




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Aloft! At The Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta

Thirty five years ago my wife and I spent a wonderful ten days driving through New Mexico, making a gigantic loop from Denver through the northern part of the state, and ending, with a bit of sadness, with only one more full day of touring, on the outskirts of Albuquerque.
