

Beware of the CD. It's mpeg files, which wouldn't play in our many CD, DVD, or car CD players. We were able to use an iMac with iTunes to get it into our computer, and then create CDs from that. It's 4

hours of audio. Blank discs cost 20 cents each. It would have been nice for the publisher to splurge for the 3 extra discs. I'm giving it three stars because the content is helpful.

I love this book and if you listen and learn the characters and the chapters you will really be ready to talk to people in DK. To be clear, I am half danish and I speak it conversationally and have grown up with it in my ear every day of my life. To me, as someone who wants to get better and knows the sounds and the lilt it is a great book. It goes quickly to a place where I can learn rather than starting slowly on basic phrases for half the book. It really captures the colloquialisms, the speed of phrase, and the regional accents (the characters are each from a different region so you can learn to hear different accents). There isn't a young person KBH, an Arhus or an Odense as far as I can recall, but you will get the idea. The chapters go in an ever more complicated narrative that ends up at train offices, dinner, weather, food, restaurants, political discussions, visits to museums, arguments, etc. It is a very danish narrative and if you finish the whole thing and go to denmark you will start laughing every time you are called upon to recreate (almost verbatim) conversations.

Very confusing to follow. I've picked up the book and tried the CD a few times and it is all very confusing. I'm learning more from free podcasts. \$40 down the drain :(

Trying to teach my boyfriend Danish with this book wasn't easy. It might be my way of teaching, but most of the stuff in the book is not important to what I want him to learn. Too much technical stuff (grammar and things like that) and not enough "trial and error" where I could just correct him. It made him give up... We didn't make it through the first chapter... Bought an app instead that seems to motivate him more.

I don't understand the negative review...this is the best Danish language course on the market. Each CD has dialogues that you can listen to and follow in your book. Listening to native Danish speakers is extremely helpful in learning how to pronounce words and also helps you get the rhythm of the language. This is worth every penny.
