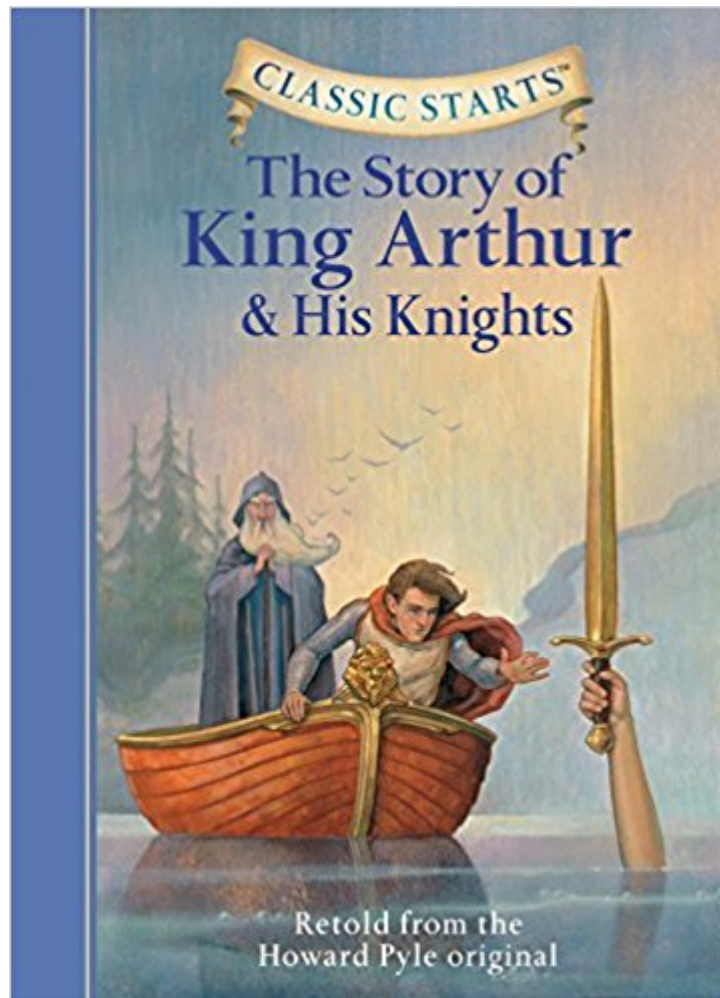

Grade 3-6—This simplified retelling of the Howard Pyle classic is accessible to readers who might not be able to handle the lengthier legends. The author maintains some of the charm of the original by using extended chapter titles such as How Arthur Performed the Miracle of the Sword and Discovered His Birthright. A concluding chapter suggests several questions for discussion. What is missing is the beautiful, though complex, language of other retellings. Additionally, the author takes a slightly moralistic tone at times when addressing readers. Though reluctant readers may have an easier time with these stories, they might not be engaged enough to want to approach the originals later on. Librarians and teachers might want to recommend audio books or some of Margaret Hodges’s picture-book versions of the King Arthur tales (Holiday House) instead of this watered-down adaptation.—Cheri Dobbs, Detroit Country Day Middle School, Beverly Hills, MI Copyright © Reed Business Information, a division of Reed Elsevier Inc. I am reading this now. It is very strange because within the text there will be words which don't make any sense although they pertain to the same story. I have to train myself to skip ahead for the word which should follow. This is very disgruntling. I am enjoying the story though and plan to finish it. They say the text is put in by volunteers, and I can understand a few typos but this just is strange. Anyone know how the volunteers put in the text? Do they type it, scan it, convert it by some other means?

Good for an eight or nine year old (or older, depending on the child). My grandson loved reading it himself, but if you were reading it to your eight year old you might want to consider Pyle's version which this is Not. I thought it was. But it's a version of Pyle's version.

This is a great book for children. Your child can be exposed to the King Arthur legends in simpler language than the original books. You can either read these aloud as bedtime stories or have your second through fourth grader read them on their own.

NO There are NO PYLE illustrations. The listing is wrong. The book is ABRIDGED even though INCORRECTLY LISTS IT IN THE TITLE AS UNABRIDGE. Plus when you click on the picture to LOOK INSIDE THE BOOK they show a title page that says WRITTEN BY AND ILLUSTRATIONS BY HOWARD PYLE WRONG they show the title page from the wrong book
