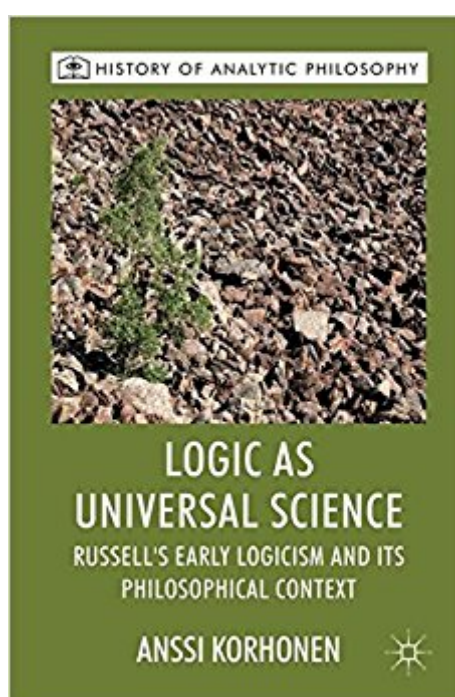


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Logic As Universal Science: Russell's Early Logicism And Its Philosophical Context (History Of Analytic Philosophy)
