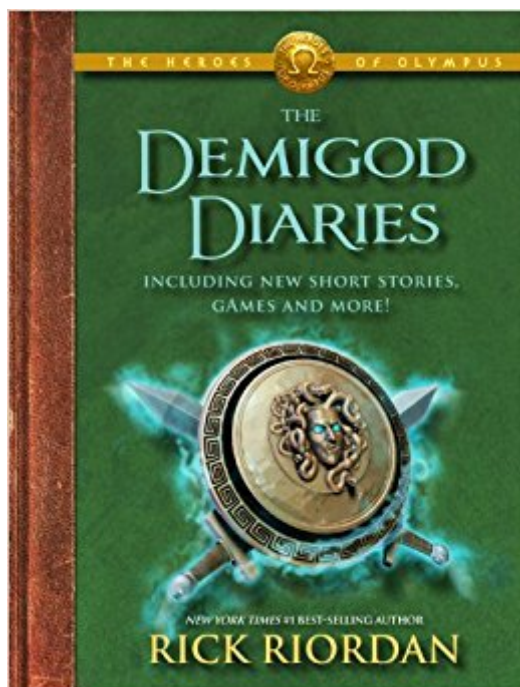

Rick Riordan ([www.rickriordan.com](http://www.rickriordan.com)) is the author of three different mythology-based series for Disney-Hyperion: the best-selling Percy Jackson series, the Kane Chronicles, and The Heroes of Olympus series. The first book in the Kane Chronicles, *The Red Pyramid*, was a number 1 New York Times bestseller. The five books in the Percy Jackson and the Olympians series have sold

millions of copies, been published in more than thirty countries, and inspired a major motion picture. Rick's novels for adults include the hugely popular Tres Navarre series, winner of the top three awards in the mystery genre. He lives in San Antonio, Texas, with his wife and two sons.

We pre-ordered the Kindle version to be delivered to my i-pad. The stories were a lot of fun (read aloud to enjoy with a family of 5, ranging in age from 12 to 72!). We are enjoying the entire "Heroes of Olympus" series, and were delighted to find these short stories to enjoy over the summer (while waiting for the next book in the series to be released in October). That said, I can't recommend the KINDLE version to others, which is why I'm giving it 4 stars instead of 5. The introductory "Letter from Camp Half-Blood" references a new illustration of the character Thalia Grace, however this illustration is nowhere to be found. The copyright page further has a byline for "color illustrations," which implies that there are multiple color illustrations in the book, none of which are included in the Kindle version. Yes, I do have the color Kindle app, and the photo of the book cover is in full color, no problem. It's just a failing in the kindle version product, evidently. Also be aware that the book includes a few paper games (such as a word search), so it really is designed for book format more than electronic.

I'm a fan of the Percy Jackson series, and have liked Heroes of Olympus even more. This "filler" book reaches into both stories, including a story of how Luke became both the villain and the hero he became in the first series.I hadn't known that the origin of the stories was as bedtime stories told by Rick Riordan to his child who had been diagnosed with dyslexia and ADHD (two signs of being a demigod, in the stories). His son has grown and is now writing his own books, and added a marvelous story of what happened to the halfbloods who served Kronos - and what happens when he is caught up in Gaea. I know other reviewers didn't care for it, but I found it very moving.Like The

Demigod Files, this is a series of filler stories, don't carry the major story forward, and some of the filler like interviews with George and Martha (the snakes on Herme's caduceus) get silly. But there are four really great stories, well worth the price.

This is definitely the book to read for Percy Jackson and Heroes of Olympus fans! Mentions things that happened before either series took place and explains so much and makes things even clearer. Entertaining! And for those fans who loved the books because there seemed to be a bunch of stories jammed into one this is perfect. Great for reading at almost anytime and almost anywhere.

I read a lot of books today as I did while growing up. I stepped into the Sci-Fi and Fantasy genre some 50 years ago and drove my World History teacher crazy with questions about the Greek and Roman Gods, what school was like then and what living then would have been like. Camp Half-Blood shows some of that, and these stories show us how a Demigod might live today. People see what they want to see is what the mist or myst is all about. I loved the the short stories in the diaries. They gave some back fill into the rest of world of Percy, Jason, Piper and I mustn't forget Annabeth. These are the stories I wish I could have written but as you can see from this review I'm not a prose writer. Still I have used them to help others start reading, both young and old. Keep up the good work and I keep buying.

The main story plots may continue, but these in between, before and after books find there ways into the big ones. True fans need to get it.
