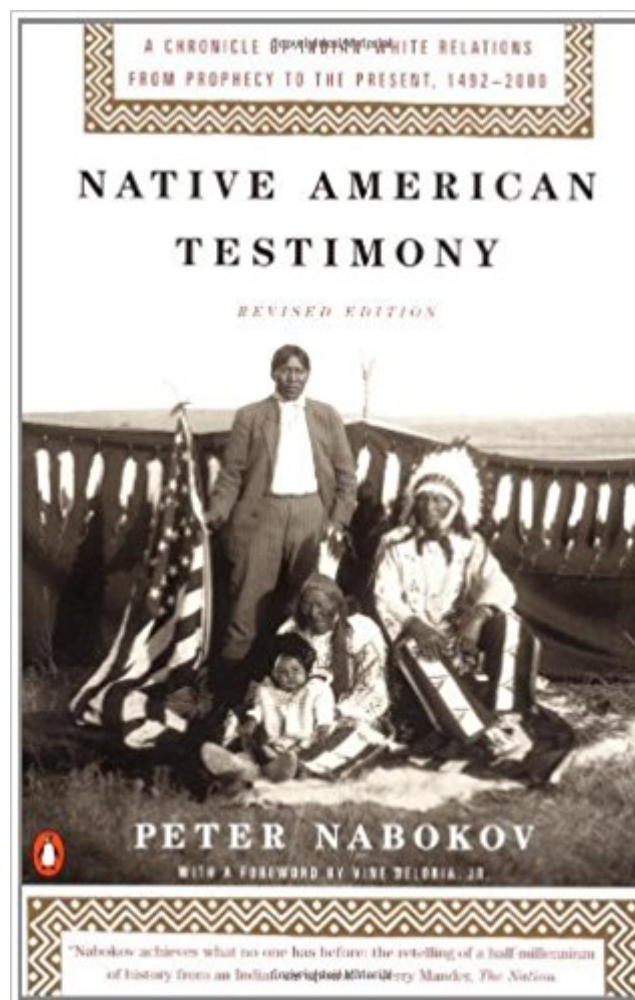




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# Native American Testimony: A Chronicle Of Indian-White Relations From Prophecy To The Present, 1492-2000, Revised Edition
