

From the first words, Aliza pulls you into the world of Maeve Parker. Your heart will move in your chest alongside Maeve as you get to know her story and the story of those who surround her. Aliza does an incredible job of bringing her characters to life and there is a real emotional connection with all the characters. If you're like me, you will possibly find yourself in tears; sad ones and happy ones - multiple times.

From its opening pages, Come Find Me, Sage Parker introduces us to characters we pull for, even in their imperfections. Aliza Latta develops those characters in a way, that by the end of the book, we want to check in on their lives ten years later to see how everyone is doing. The people we meet are reflections of people we know (even at times, self-reflections), and their choices and responses are at times frustrating, inspiring, hopeful, and more. At 16, Maeve has lived a lot of life, the kind that grows you up fast and informs your perspective. She doesn't always have the best judgment, but there are a few pivotal characters who keep pointing her to better ways and love her with no condition. People evolve. It's heartening to see such a young author fleshing out her characters in three dimensions. I don't always like where they go, but strands of beauty from brokenness and redemption thread silver linings. Buy this book (or read it free on Kindle for a short while!). It's a fast read, and when Aliza Latta is farther along in her career as a novelist, you'll be able to say you've watched her from the beginning.
