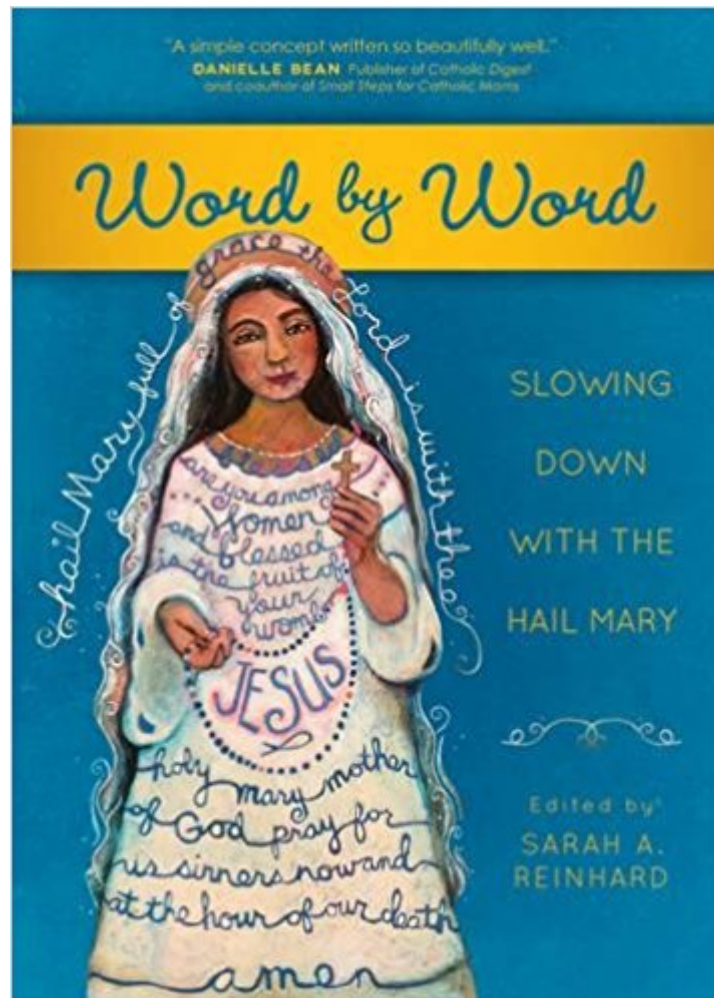

The minute I heard about this book I bought it because I loved the concept. It's often the simple act of thinking on one word that reveals to you a spiritual truth. I am halfway through this book so far and love it! Each meditation is short and thoughtful--perfect for a daily devotional. At the end of each chapter we're asked to think on the theme of the meditation while praying the Hail Mary. I find I don't want to go beyond the words I have already read about because I want to stop and recall what I had read. For unknown reasons I have struggled trying to draw close to Mary--I've done consecrations that have gone nowhere. This little volume has done more than anything I've tried to draw me closer to my Blessed Mother. Thank you to the team of writers and the wonderful Sarah Reinhard for her editing.

I've given this book away several times and have one by my night stand. Word by Word: Slowing Down with the Hail Mary is a wonderful way to spend your Lent, 40 days, 41 words, or to deepen your prayer life. One wouldn't think you could get so much out of the word "the" or "of" but each word of the prayer, as contemplated by any one of the 41 authors of these little meditations, is rich to the marrow, pregnant with wisdom.
