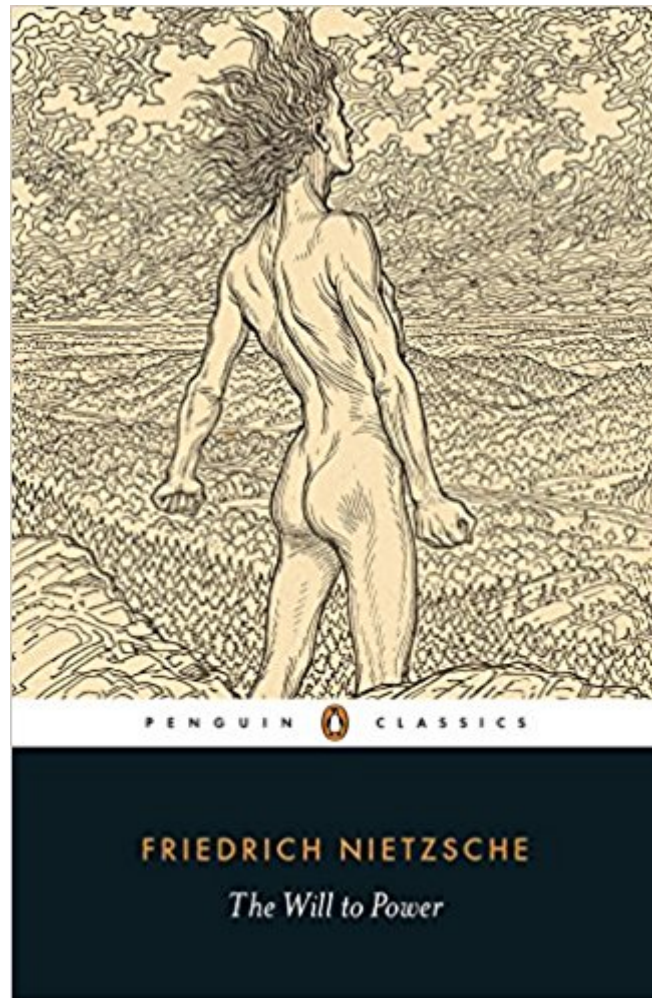


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# The Will To Power (Penguin Classics)

I've known that this was not a completed work by Nietzsche, but I was not aware as to how far it was from being complete, which is quite substantial. 5 stars for Kaufmann's wonderful and truthful to the text translations, but as for the "philosophy" in it, I recommend one read Nietzsche's words in His released books: Thus Spoke Zarathustra, Ecce Homo, Beyond Good and Evil etc... and Kaufmann's translations are always the best for that.
