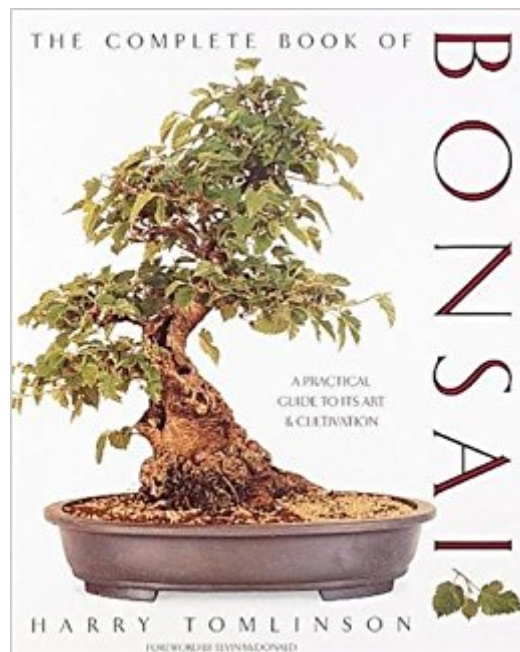

Harry Tomlinson is one of Europe's leading bonsai artists and instructors. He has been both studying and practicing the principles of bonsai for almost thirty years, and is an internationally recognized authority on the subject. He has exhibited bonsai and gained awards in Britain and Japan, and has judged the bonsai section at Britain's world-famous Chelsea Flower Show. For the past thirteen years the author has been a professional bonsai artist with his own studio, and is a leading bonsai nurseryman. Greenwood Bonsai Studio, which he runs with his wife Christine, is the largest and most complete bonsai nursery in Britain. The Complete Book of Bonsai by Harry Tomlinson is among the best I've read, probably 2nd only to the Bonsai Art of Kamura (for the fan or advanced practitioner). It covers a broad range of trees in various styles and at various ages, with plenty of full color illustrations. Many start to finish examples are given, with different viewing angles and close ups. I recommend it for both those starting out as well as those desiring to "branch out". Its compendium at the back with care instructions is very complete. Probably one of the best all in one Bonsai publications.

Harry Tomlinson has created a tome easy to read and apply when working with bonsai. Other books bog down and are too vague for most hobbyists. This reference is clear and easy to follow.

The book is OK, it contains some brief information on the basics of the art. However much of this can be accessed online, with much more detail and examples. The one good point about this book is its nice pictures and decent species list. If you want a book to skim through during the TV commercials, this is it.
